The TWU Joint Negotiating Committee represents Title III Fleet Service, Title IV Ground Service, Title V Stock Clerks, Simulator Pilot and Ground School Instructors, and Flight Simulator Technicians.

*Your Joint Negotiation Committee continues to hold its scheduled meetings with the company. Details of each Sub-Committee meeting will be released as they occur.*

#### **Title III Fleet Service and Title IV Ground Services**

*The Title III Fleet Service/Ground Service Sub-Committee met in Dallas on Monday, June 30. Counter proposals on Article 5-Shift Differential, Article 6-Overtime-and Article 39-Physical Examination were received from the company. Afterwards, much deliberation within the sub-committee on our current position and that which it would be going forward took place.*

*On Tuesday, July 1, the Fleet/Ground Sub-Committee met again with the company negotiation team and put forth a short-term comprehensive proposal that would provide temporary and immediate relief to our fleet/ground members during this challenging economic period. Due to negotiations protocol agreements, details cannot yet be released.*
